Complementary and Alternative Medicine Fellowship

War Related Illness and Injury Study Center

Veterans Affairs Medical Center, Washington, DC

This is a two year funded academic fellowship that is open to a licensed physician with acupuncture training. August 1, 2011-July 31, 2013.

The War Related Illness and Injury Study Center was formed after national legislation was passed in 1998 that directed the VA to develop centers that specialize in study and treatment of combat related illnesses and injuries. Its work centers on four key areas—clinical care, risk communication, research, and education. At the Center located in Washington there is strong interest in Complementary and Alternative Medicine, and this Fellowship was initiated in 2009.

Clinical Opportunities within the Fellowship include inpatient and outpatient treatment of Veterans in both individual acupuncture treatments and in group auricular acupuncture. There is a full spectrum of clinical diagnoses among the Veterans, whose ages range from early 20's through senior years. Many Veterans are referred to WRIISC with difficult-to-diagnose and difficult-to-treat syndromes.

Research is a fundamental component of WRIISC. There are many opportunities at the VA for conducting research on complementary and alternative medicine. Our current acupuncture project is titled "Effect of Auricular Acupuncture on Insomnia in OIF/OEF Veterans with PTSD". Development of new projects will be ongoing. There are also opportunities for collaborative research, e.g. with neuroscientists working in nervous system imaging techniques.

Educational aspects of the Fellowship are abundant. Within this VA Medical Center opportunities which are incorporated include instruction in Environmental Exposure and didactic training with Palliative Care and Geriatrics Fellows. In addition, attendance at Neurology and Medical Grand Rounds is encouraged. Provisions are also made for support for attendance at continuing education activities related to the work of WRIISC.

Likewise, education of the Medical Center staff about Complementary and Alternative Medicine is a part of the WRIISC mandate. This entails preparing presentations for various departmental meetings and Grand Rounds. It also involves development of venues for fostering integration of services and research between departments. One such activity is the monthly combined conference between WRIISC and the Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation/Polytrauma Department. Also, there are opportunities to present information about Complementary and Alternative Medicine work within WRIISC to various visiting groups; this year these included the VA regional Leadership Development Team and Brigham Young School of Nursing students.

A unique component of this Fellowship is the opportunity to promote integration of Complementary and Alternative Medicine within this particular Medical Center and on a national basis. Development of an Integrative Health Center is underway here at the DCVA. WRIISC is taking a central role in this project. In addition, within the biannual national WRIISC meeting we have developed a plenary segment on CAM and have generated a half-day CAM Workshop to address the national status of CAM within the VA system, CAM research within the VA Healthcare System, and establishment of Integrative Health Centers within VA's.

Finally there are ample opportunities to develop the integration of CAM by participation in multiple special VA programs. An example this spring was provision of CAM modalities at the "Ladies Night", which was a very successful evening program provided for female Veterans to inform them of benefits and services available to them.
